HAZARIBAG - the land of thousand gardens.

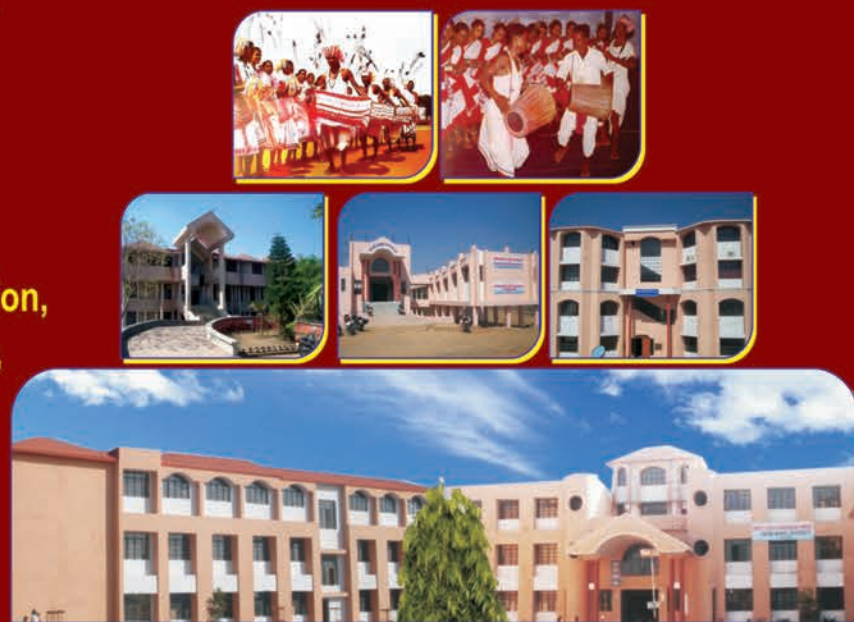
- »Famous Health Resort Town of India.
