**Academic requirements**

Applicants must hold a BA in Philosophy (or a degree equivalent to a BA in Philosophy). Applicants must already be enrolled in a Master course in Philosophy at their home University. In order to apply, they must provide records of the exams they have taken to obtain their BA in Philosophy and they must declare which exams they will have taken by the end of their first year of the Master program at their home institution. Prior to enrolment in our Master degree, the student must exhibit records certifying that (s)he has passed the exams (s)he has declared.

Successful applicants will be enrolled at Milan University for a second year Master degree. A double Indian-Italian degree can be possibly awarded.

Successful applicants are expected to take five courses in Philosophy and to complete their Master Thesis with the help of a supervisor chosen among the professors of the Philosophy Department of the Università degli Studi di Milano.

The Philosophy Department of the Università degli Studi di Milano counts forty members in its Faculty, working in all the main areas of Philosophy. It promotes and coordinates research activities concerning critical, methodological and foundational issues. It operates in several areas and aims at keeping alive the theoretical debate between researchers engaged in philosophical investigation and those working in the sciences.

For foreign applicants we offer the following five courses in English, each of which is worth 9 ECTS (European Credit Transfer System) for a total of 45 ECTS:

History of Contemporary Philosophy  
History of Contemporary Metaphysics  
Philosophy of History  
Philosophy of Science  
Philosophical Analysis

Added to the credits obtained by writing a Master Thesis (which is worth 21 ECTS), this brings to 66 ECTS the number of credits obtained by the student, which corresponds to the average number of credits required for our second year Master students.

Applicants must submit a research project to the department for approval before they can be considered for enrolment.
